FUNDING: Budget of the Port Authority of Kribi. 2024 FY.

1. PURPOSE OF THE CALL FOR TENDERS

The General Manager of the Port Authority of Kribi, Project Owner, hereby launches a Call for Tenders to supply and commission equipment to monitor the fibre optic network in the Port Authority of Kribi, especially the Port Administrative Building in Mboro.

2. NATURE OF SERVICES

Services covered by this Call for Tenders shall comprise of the following:

- Supply of a UPS;
- Supply of OLTs;
- Supply of UN type termination equipment;
- Supply of fibre optic monitoring equipment and materials;
- Supply of accessories for the installation of fibre optic equipment;
- Installation and configuration of fibre optic equipment;
- Staff training for skills transfer.

Details on the equipment shall be provided in the Technical Specifications.

3. DELIVERYTIME

The maximum time provided by the Project Owner for the delivery of the equipment shall be six (06) months.

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4. ALLOTMENT

This Call for Tenders shall not be divided.

5. PROVISIONAL COST

The provisional cost for the supplies shall be one hundred and forty-five million (145,000,000) CFAF all tax included.

6. Participation and origin

This Call for Tenders is open to companies established in Cameroon and specialised in selling such equipment.

7. FUNDING

Services covered by this Call for Tenders shall be funded by the budget of the Port Authority of Kribi, 2024 FY allocated as follows Task 5113001 "development and operation of local networks and telecommunications", Line 235800 "other amenagement".

11. BID BOND

Bids must be accompanied by a bid bond issued by a financial institution or a first-rate banking institution approved by the Minister in charge of finance (see Document 11 in the Tender File) to be automatically released no later than 30 days after the expiry of the validity of the tenders and amounting to two million nine hundred thousand (2,900,000) CFAF.

12. ADMISSIBILITY OF BIDS

Under penalty of rejection, administrative documents required must be provided in originals or copies certified by the issuing institution or the competent administrative authority in accordance with the provisions of the Specific Rules of the Call for Tenders.

They must have been issued less than three (3) months after the signing date of the Tender File.

13. OPENING OF BIDS

The opening of bids shall take place in one stage.

The opening of the administrative, technical and financial bids shall take place on 0.5 MRS 2024 at 1 p.m. by the Internal Procurement Committee of the Port Authority of Kribi in the Conference Room located on the 2nd floor of the PAK 2-storey building in Kribi. Bidders or their duly mandated representatives shall attend this opening session.

14. EVALUATION CRITERIA

1.3. ELIMINATOR CRITERIA

1) Insufficient number of copies of offers (less than 07 offers)

2) Administrative file

- Incomplete administrative file:
- Non-compliance of an administrative document after the 48-hour deadline granted by the CIPM;
- Non-compliant bid bond.

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3) Technical file

- technical score less than 70/100
- False statement or forged documents;
- Non-acceptance of the contract conditions (Specific Technical Clauses (CCTP), Special Administrative Clauses (CCAP), declaration of commitment to respect environmental social clauses or Integrity Charter not initialed on each page, no - signed, unsealed and undated by the bidder on the last page);
- Non-compliance with all the technical specifications of the equipment
- Non-compliance with 3 key criteria out of 4.

4) Financial file

- No quantified unit price.
- No sub-details of quantified unit prices.

1.4. KEY CRITERIA

The key criteria pertaining to the qualification of candidates shall focus on:

1.	Bidder's experience and financing capacity	Oui/Non
2.	Equipment delivery time and planning	Oui/Non
3.	Customer care	Oui/Non
4.	Human and material resources	Oui/Non

Any bid that is not in line with all the eliminatory criteria and that complies with three (3) out of four (4) eliminatory criteria shall be dismissed.

15. AWARD

The contract shall be awarded to the bidder complying with the required technical and financial capacities of the key or eliminatory criteria and with the **most competitive** bid.

16. VALIDITY OF BIDS

Bidders shall be bound by their tenders for ninety (90) days with effect from the tender submission deadline $M_{\rm A}$
