Purpose of the Call for Tenders

The General Manager of the Port Authority of Kribi, Project Owner, hereby launches a Call for Tenders to provide IT consumables and spare parts to the Port Authority of Kribi.

2. NATURE OF SERVICES

Services covered by this Call for Tenders are the supply of IT consumables and spare parts to the Port Authority of Kribi.

Details on supplies are provided in the Description of Supplies.

3. DELIVERY TIME

The maximum deadline provided by the Project Owner for the supply of IT consumables shall be four (4) months.

4. ALLOTMENT

This call for Tenders shall not be divided.

5. PROVISIONAL COST

The provision cost for all the services shall be two hundred and fifty million (250,000,000) CFA francs all tax inclusive.

6. Participation and origin

This Call for Tenders is open to Cameroonian companies specialised in supplying IT equipment and consumables.

7. FUNDING

Services covered by this Call for Tenders shall be funded by the Budget of the Port Authority of Kribi, 2024 FY.

The copy of the receipt shall be submitted when submitting bids at the Tender File at the Public Contracts Division of the Port Authority of Kribi.

10. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

Each bid drafted in French or English in seven (7) copies among which one (1) original and six (6) copies marked as such must be received no later than on $\frac{10.2 \text{ AVR}}{2024}$ at 12 p.m. prompt, local time at the following address:

11. BID BOND

Bids must be accompanied by a bid bond issued by a first-rate banking or financial institution approved by the Minister in charge of finance (see Document 10 in the Tender File) to be automatically released no later than 30 days after the expiry of the validity of the tenders and amounting to five hundred thousand (500,000) CFA francs.



12. ADMISSIBILITY OF BIDS

Under penalty of rejection, administrative documents required must be provided in originals or copies certified by the issuing institution or the competent administrative authority in accordance with the provisions of the Specific Rules of the Call for Tenders. They must have been issued less than three (3) months before the original date of submission of bids.

13. OPENING OF BIDS

The opening of bids shall take place in one stage.

The opening of administrative, technical and financial files shall take place on 2.2 AVR. 2024 at 1 p.m. prompt by the Internal Procurement Committee of the Port Authority of Kribi in the conference room at the 2nd floor of the PAK 2-storey Building in Kribi.

Bidders or their duly mandated representatives shall attend this opening session.

14. EVALUATION CRITERIA

1.1. ELIMINATORY CRITERIA

- 1) Insufficient number of copies (less than 7 copies);
- 2) Administrative file
 - Incomplete administrative file;
 - Failure to provide a compliant administrative document after the 48-hour deadline provided by the Internal Procurement Committee;
 - False statement or forged document.
- 3) Technical file
 - No leaflets with technical data sheets;
 - No approval or authorisation from the manufacturer or no contract binding the supplier to the Manufacturer or to one of its authorised distributors;
 - 100% non-compliance with technical specifications for supplies;
 - False statement or forged document;
 - Non-acceptance of the terms and conditions of the contract (Description of supplies, Special Administrative Specifications (CCAP), declaration of commitment to comply with the social and environmental clauses or Integrity Charter not initialled on each page, not signed, not sealed and not dated by the bidder on the last page);
 - Non-compliance with 5 key criteria out of 6.
- 4) Financial file
 - No quantified unit price;
 - No sub-details on quantified unit prices.



1.2. KEY CRITERIA

The key criteria for the qualification of candidates shall focus on:

1.	Bidder's experience	Yes/No
2.	Bidder's financing capacity	Yes/No
3.	Execution methodology	Yes/No
4.	Customer care	Yes/No
<i>5.</i>	Human resources	Yes/No
6.	Material resources	Yes/No

Any bid that does not comply with all eliminatory criteria and with less than 5 evaluation criteria out of 6 shall be dismissed

15. AWARD

The contract shall be awarded to the bidder meeting all eliminatory criteria and with the most competitive bid.

16. VALIDITY OF BIDS

Bidders shall be bound by their tenders for ninety (90) days with effect from the tender submission deadline.
